Sections 71 to 74 of the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act 2005

I write further to my letter of 15 July 2016, which related to the number of agreements made under sections 71 to 74 of the Serious Organised Crime and Police Act 2005 (SOCPA).

In the interests of transparency, the CPS publishes the number of such agreements entered into on an annual basis. My letter of 15 July was published on the CPS website and I am now writing to inform you of the latest numbers of agreements entered into between 1 May 2016 and 30 April 2017. These are set out in the table below:
