The Crown Prosecution Service (CPS) does not encourage prosecutors to cherry pick cases (such as performance targets) that have led inevitably to a detrimental effect on the course of justice.

All charging decisions are made in accordance with the same two-stage test as set out in the Code for Crown Prosecutors:

- 1. Does the evidence provide a realistic prospect of conviction? and;
- 2. Is it in the public interest to prosecute?
